A Prophetic Look at 2005, *by Rex & Lois Burgher*

Often people ask us at the beginning of the year what we may be sensing the Lord is saying to His church for the specific year we are presently in. Since I have been asked to speak about this at the first two churches we are going to I also felt God was prompting me to I write an article on what we are sharing.

Last year in 2004 the word that was coming forth across the 'Prophetic Billboards' was 'Open Doors in 2004'. Personally Lois and I took this to heart, realizing a couple of things. One is that doors swing both ways, doors lead you out into something and they also close off things behind you. We saw last year as an opportunity to enter into the prophetic promises spoken over us in former years as well as closing doors to disappointments of the past that have hindered us from being all we can be in God. Therefore we took the word to mean and also to purpose in our hearts that those negative doors of the past were going to be closed for good. There have been doors that have closed behind us that have given us a greater freedom in the spirit than we have experienced for several years.

We looked at many doors during the past 12 months, some we just peered into and others we ventured forth for a short distance before returning back while others we walked into and are continually walking in them.

I perceive that Romans 8:19 is key for this year, "*The earth is groaning as in childbirth for the sons of God to be revealed.*" is the scripture revealing the Father's heart for the season ahead.

Following are four things that I believe the Lord wants His family to come to realize this year.

1. The release of true *Apostolic Fathers & Mothers*
2. Finding contentment in the '*Moment*'
3. The '*language of Love*' is being birthed anew!
4. Desire to express their '*Love in ACTION*'

First, the Apostolic Movement is coming to the place where you can see the final stage of birthing beginning to

take place. The apostolic baby that has been coming down the birth canal for the past 9 years was first revealed to the church in 2004. The nineties was the time of the impregnation to a large part of the church to the reality of the apostolic ministry. This coincided with the 'Father's Blessing' being released in Toronto in 1994 and in Pensacola on Father's Day 1995. Even though the birth took place through last year and into this year, many in their spirits are sensing what the baby is looking like. I believe that God is revealing to us that the return of the Father and Mother's to the church is at hand.

It is definitely true that some of the outward signs of the apostolic ministry are thousands being saved, signs and wonders, churches being planted and a many other outward visible qualities. But I really am sensing that God is more interested in true Father's and Mother's being raised up in the church than all the rest. When it comes to family, the church is as dysfunctional in raising its children as the world has become. One way we know this is that the rate of divorce within the church is at par with secular society. We have spent the past 50 years doing a remarkable job of equipping the saints but we have truly neglected maturing the saints for the work of the ministry.

We are beginning to see true Father and Mother's coming forth that will stand for Godly principles. They will be *community oriented*, not racing around from meeting to meeting but finding true contentment in doing family things. Wanting to be with their spiritual children and taking delight in watching them grow into adulthood and going into the destinies that God has for them. They will know how to bring correction when needed and by their example many in the body as well as out will marvel at how they interact with others.

This will shake up many within the body of Christ because it will not be based on spiritual age but spiritual maturity. Many in leadership today will have to step down so that humility can do its work in them before they will be raised back up. Others will not step down but will continue

to use secular methods that the world uses to grow successful ministries. They will find success in their endeavors but it will become quite evident to many spirit filled people that the house they built is not a home.

Second, we will find our commitments to the busyness of our lives begin to change. For many of us we live in a time when we are disappointed in what we accomplished yesterday and so overwhelmed by what we have to do tomorrow that we never find contentment in the moment. From the moment we wake up till the time we go to sleep we are reminded of all the things we didn't get done yesterday and all we have to do tomorrow to such a degree that many of us never really have the opportunity to enjoy the day they are presently in. This is why many so many people wake up in the morning not rested.

I have observed people receiving prophetic words, they sit on the edge of their seats waiting to receive a word then, when they do, the place of resting doesn't last very long till they once again are sitting on the edge waiting for another word, often within the same day of receiving the first word. We have conversations with people all the while looking over the person's shoulder hoping a better conversation will come along. That is how many of us are living our lives and God is giving us all a chance to 'redeem the day'. The joy of the moment is coming to many within the church. You will find yourself resting in conversations not worried about what you are not getting done but enjoying the kairos moment that God has brought your way. We will really want to know about a person's life, asking them questions and finding out their hopes and dreams. Then we will find ourselves connecting with them with a heartfelt desire to see them succeed in their quest for their destinies. Many will be finding themselves going to sleep at night content that it was a 'good day' with an overwhelming feeling of contentment that will lead into a deep rest.

A Voiceless Cry, by Rex Burgher

Lois and I shivered during the time we stood at the base of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington D.C. as the wind chill brought the temperatures into the single digits. What brought us here was a 'call' that Lou Engle had put out several years previous that had mobilized thousands of young people, now the 'call' had culminated in a 'cause' and that was why we were here with hundreds of people from across this land of ours to be apart of a non-violent demonstration on the birthday of Martin Luther King. This is the hour and the day that Christians must come together and mobilize themselves, seizing the kairos moment that is before us to stop the carnage that has been going on continually for close to 33 years.

We were all there to lift prayers to heaven on behalf of the 47.3 million babies aborted in this country since 1973. For most of us 47.3 million is beyond our ability to comprehend, but more realistically it comes down to this, every month in the United States 150,000 babies are aborted. That is 4,400 per day, 185/hour or 1 every 20 seconds. If the blood of a single man, Abel cries out from the ground for revenge how much more the shedding of these innocent babies cries out for justice against our land. (Gen.4:10)

In the last few months hundreds of people have made the march alongside of Lou to stand upon the steps of the Supreme Court building to protest this abomination in our land. One of the young men with Lou had a dream in which he saw them with tape over their mouths with the word 'LIFE' printed on them as a silent protest to the millions aborted who were unable to voice their desire to live.

As the wind blew through my coat while I listened to the speakers my mind went back to Biblical times and the false God Molech. Molech, (or Molek) was the chief god of the Phoenicians, Canaanites and Ammonites, probably known to the Israelites before King Solomon. Human sacrifices were offered to him, mainly firstborn children, the victims were slowly burned to death in the outstretched arms of this idol, which were metal, hollow and could be heated on the inside. Some say they fell into the fire below. Manasech offered his son to Molech. Solomon erected an altar to this god on one of the summits of Mount Olivet. (1 Kings 11:7) This idol worshipping continued there and in Tophet until Josiah abolished it and defiled the altars. (2 Kings 23:30) Molech was also worshipped in Carthage, where at one time about 200 little boys were sacrificed in hopes of saving that city from siege.

My thoughts went to asking how

could anyone do such a horrendous thing as to place these new born infants in the arms of this metal monster? Suddenly my mind took a turn and I heard these words in my spirit. It was Satan talking to his underlings. Satan was saying, "Look at them, I have gotten them to burn their babies but there is coming a time when I will even have them do worse things to their children." The demons around him looked at each other and said with words trembling, "How could they do anything worse than this?" Even before the words

came out they knew that the prince of this world was capable of incredible evil, and they listened as he unfolded his evil plan. "You see now what they will do to one of their own at such a young age but soon they will be injecting fire into their own wombs to kill them with a burning from within before they see the light of day. Others will be ripped from limb to limb within the womb, such horror will happen and they will believe they are doing a good thing. Such deception will come upon them that the church will be silent while this takes place."

I staggered as my mind went over what had just transpired. Was it my imagination or was the Holy Spirit telling me something. This has led me into a study of abortion in our land, is it a 'woman's right to choose' or is the evil god Molech alive and well in the United States.

'Planned Parenthood' the organization that has the abortion clinics around the United States was founded by a woman by the name of Margaret Sanger. Sanger was born in Corning, NY on Sept. 14, 1879 and she passed away on Sept. 6, 1966 at the age of 86. She was a very con-

troversial individual in her day but very few of us understand the deceptive darkness that was behind the public agenda she championed as a 'woman's choice'.

Margaret Sanger first came to the attention of the world with her desire to have the African Americans in the United States sterilized. First and foremost at the core of her organization was the eradication of what she refers to as inferior races within the United States. Sanger knew blacks were a religious people—she also knew how useful ministers would be to her project, and to expedite her cause she was able to deceive and enlist African American Ministers.

Margaret Sanger, "The minister's work is also important and he should be trained, perhaps by the Federation as to our ideals and the goal that we hope to reach. We do not want word to go out that we want to exterminate the Negro population, and the minister is the man who can straighten out that idea if it ever occurs to any of their more rebellious members."

"We should hire three or four colored ministers, preferably with social-service backgrounds, and with engaging personalities. The most successful educational approach to the Negro is through a religious appeal. We don't want the word to go out that we want to exterminate the Negro population..."

Margaret wanted to eradicate those within society that she considered to be of bad stock,

"Our failure to segregate morons who are increasing and multiplying... a dead weight of human waste... an ever-increasing, unceasingly spawning class of human beings who never should have been born at all."

"The undeniably feeble-minded should, indeed, not only be discouraged but prevented from propagating their kind."

"Margaret Sanger, proposed the American Baby Code that states, "No woman shall have the legal right to bear a child... without a permit for parenthood". She also proposed the Population Congress with the aim, "...to give certain dysgenic groups in our population their choice of segregation or sterilization."

Today we see that most Planned Parenthood offices are in poor black communities. This has been so successful that in the black communities alone only one out of three babies make it out of the womb alive! In Washington DC more babies are aborted than are born. The census figures

show that since the beginning of this organization the African American race has had a steady decline within the United States.

"Abortion is the number-one killer of blacks in America," says Rev. Hunter of LEARN. "We're losing our people at the rate of 1,452 a day. That's just pure genocide. There's no other word for it. [Sanger's] influence and the whole mindset that Planned Parenthood has brought into the black community ... say it's okay to destroy your people. We bought into the lie; we bought into the propaganda."

And he built altars in the house of The Lord, of which The Lord had said, "In Jerusalem shall My Name be for ever." And he built altars for all the host of heaven in the two courts of the house of The Lord. And he burned his sons as an offering in the valley of the son of Hinnom, and practiced soothsaying and augury and sorcery, and dealt with mediums and with wizards. He did much evil in the sight of The Lord" (2 Chronicles 33:4-6 RSV)

One of Sanger's closest board members was Gamble of Proctor and Gamble fame. Gamble wrote a memorandum in November 1939 entitled "Suggestions for the Negro Project," in which he recognized that "black leaders might regard birth control as an extermination plot." One person whose interest was peaked over the organization of Sanger and Gamble was Adolph Hitler. Hitler and his aids exchanged letters with the central board members of 'Planned Parenthood'.

In 1933, when the Nazi's came to power, the law was changed to legalize abortion and make this a matter of decision for a medical review board. The development of Germany's abortion policy was left to the county's most vociferous abortion advocacy group, the Berlin Chamber of Physicians. This group, which advocated abortion on demand, determined that "The health of the mother - considered from all angles - is the decisive factor." Then, just as now, health of the mother criterion was loosely understood

There were approximately 500,000 abortions annually in Germany

under the Third Reich, a country of 60 to 70 million people. And, in Nazi Germany, racial stock was considered an aspect of the health of the mother. If she was from an "unhealthy" race, such as Polish, Czech or Jewish, then she was often forced to have an abortion against her will. However, race wasn't the only consideration. Hitler actively promoted the destruction of the crippled, poor and unemployed classes, as did Margaret Sanger, founder of Planned Parenthood. Abortion led to forced sterilization, which led to "euthanasia," which led to Auschwitz.

Margaret Sanger's American Birth Control League, which later became Planned Parenthood, published a magazine called Birth Control Review. Here are some quotes from their magazine. The ideas expressed by this group, along with the statements of Margaret Sanger cited above, promote a scheme that seeks to make race or class the determining factor in the use of birth control and abortion. Was Planned Parenthood's founder a racist who taught that some races or classes are superior, while other races or classes are inherently inferior? The quotes here and above reveal the answer.

"Not only is it our task to prevent the multiplication of bad stocks; it is also to preserve the well-endowed stocks."

"... in the interest of social progress or the permanence even of civilization, the intellectual classes should have more children."

"Our most pressing problem is to increase the birth rate from the superior and decrease that from the inferior."

"... it would also lead to racial improvement to sterilize even those feeble-minded who do not necessarily fall in the hereditary group."

"Negroes and Southern Europeans are mentally inferior to native born Ameri-

cans"

"More children from the fit, less from the unfit."

"...apply a stern and rigid policy of sterilization and segregation to that grade of population whose progeny is already tainted, or whose inheritance is such that objectionable traits may be transmitted to offspring."

"Birth control must lead ultimately to a cleaner race."

We Christians must not become so desensitized to the evil within our midst that we no longer hear the cries of those who are too weak to speak or act for themselves.

Lou Engle said in 2004 "Our nation is in desperate need of historic revival leading to righteous reformation! God says that if we humble ourselves and turn from our ways He will come and heal our land. We can no longer ignore the stains of iniquity that unjust laws and judges have spilled on our country! The recent elections were critical for our nation, but we cannot back down in the battle for justice. The decisions being made in this hour will shape the judicial future of our nation for decades to come. God hates injustice! Will we be governed with justice and righteousness or will we sit back in silence and allow relativism and compromise to set the tone for those in our halls of law and justice? President Bush is set to nominate one if not several Supreme Court Justices in this term. Roe v. Wade is already in the process of being reintroduced to the Supreme Court in January 2005. As can be seen from history, these appointments and decisions carry far greater influence on the fabric of our nation than any four-year presidential term. Like Moses who held up his hands in prayer while Joshua fought in the valley below, we must win a decisive battle in the spirit or face defeat in the ground war on earth."

Third, a new way of speaking to one another is coming back into the church. This is not a new language but a return of the way we spoke to one another during the first century church. When we are born naturally we have the nature of Satan, the prince of this world or the god of this age. But when we are 'born again' of the spirit we take on the nature of our Father in heaven. With that new nature comes a new language. For those who overcome and find contentment in the moment they will be the first to come into this new language. Finding rest in the day receiving encouragement or correct discipline from loving parents will give hope to our spiritual children so that the striving will cease bringing us all into a season of mature contentment. Then our language will begin to change as love overflowing from the depths of our healed hearts will bring forth a God given desire to love our God with all our heart, soul and mind leading us to truly love others as we have learned to love ourselves.

Because we have not had true spiritual Father's and Mother's many of us have never received the encouragement and/or correction we have needed to bring us into spiritual maturity. Many of us have been wandering around, wondering why we are here, what we are to do

and when if ever, we will be released to do what God has so wonderfully planned for us to do. Father God is telling us to relax and let Him lead us into a place of peace where our spirits, mind and body will be in one accord with Him. Living each moment without fear, time constraints and doubts. Once we begin to experience this peace we will truly be led by the Spirit as Jesus was led.

Romans 8:13-15, "*For if you live according to the sinful nature, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live, because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."*

These times will come to those who are purposing to contend for them. Many will have to shake up their schedules forcing themselves out of the ruts they are in so that change will be allowed to occur. Words like self-control and perseverance are crucial but will be easier to do than we have ever experienced because there will be a grace upon it as it is central to the Father's heart. "*The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of God to be revealed.*" Romans 8:19

Fourth is that the church will

begin to stand up for injustices that have been grieving the Father's heart. The Father wants his children to know that he is neither Republican nor Democrat and He desires His children to be steeped in His word having His values, fighting for those who are defenseless. Love is a verb and it will become active in the hearts of His children once again. He is looking for a church who, *grieves and laments over all the detestable things that are done in the land.* (Ezekiel 9:4) It is imperative that Fathers and Mothers be revealed at this time to the family of Christ. The absence of parents within the church is coming to an end. Disobedience over matters of integrity, holiness and righteousness will not be passed by. You will be finding more and more people speaking out concerning what is right and wrong in our doing 'church as usual'. Within the hearts of the children of God is a desire to feed the poor, help the homeless and taking care of the widows and orphans. Patiently they have waited for those in charge to lead the way, now you will begin to see them either going out on their own or coming alongside of those who are already there.

This is still the year of the open doors that swing both ways. Be sons and daughters of God that have learned to 'seize the day'. THE END

A Mother's Cry of Desperation and a Child's Miraculous Healing!!

The front of the church was overflowing with those who had received prayer from Lois and I leaving only the center isle for me to go down while Lois focused on another area. Suddenly a woman in the pew beside me went into travail. Over and over she cried out to God from somewhere deep within herself. "Why me God, Why me!" she cried over and over as tears and sobs racked her body. Two women from the church came and were ministering to her but with little affect. I leaned over and asked them if they could take her to a private room and pray with her. With a little effort they were able to move her to a private room.

About an hour later as we were finishing our time of ministry I happened to be going by the room in back when she was coming out. She came up to me and told me how appreciative she was of our ministry. Isabel was from Brazil, married an American man and had been living in the United States for a few years. I asked her what she was traveling about and she told me her story.

"Three years ago I had a baby boy. He was fine for about six months and there contracted a bad ear infection and a 103-degree temperature. For one so young that is really bad but he got better and the temperature returned to normal but since then his ears have always hurt him. At times he cries so much and screams. I cannot do anything to help him. The Doctors gave him antibiotics but they gave him sores in his mouth and it was very bad. You cannot be on them forever and so we tried to live with the nights of little sleep. My husband works two jobs to help and I am so tired. That is why I was crying so much, I am so tired and it hurts to see him hurting so much."

I asked if I could pray and she agreed. I asked God to come and touch her son right now. I looked at the clock above my head as it read 8:43 and I said right now your son is being healed. For most of you who know me that is not the way I normally pray but God had given me supernatural faith. We didn't see Isabel the next day and quite frankly I had forgotten all about it, but during our last night she came up to me all beaming telling me how her life had changed so much. I asked her what happened and this is what she said.

"When I went home that night I asked my husband how things had gone. He said that the boy had suddenly begun to cry and cry. He cried really hard for 20 minutes and as quickly as he started he stopped. He has not cried since then and when I asked him what happened he said this to me".

"Mommy, Jesus came up to me and touched my ear and took all my pain away."

"I am so happy, you and your wife have come to our church, it has changed my life, thank you, thank you so much for coming and being with us."

Lois and I give all the glory to God for what he has done in the life of the little boy and the life of the entire family. Most of the time when we go out we never get the chance to hear stories like this because of our having to leave so soon after the meetings are over. I pray this story will be a testimony to you of the love of the Father and that you will be encouraged to pray for the sick every chance you get.
